

Valedictorian Photo Submission Guidelines

Please make sure when submitting your valedictorian application package that you've submitted your photo!

Please see the criteria below to ensure we can accept your picture:

- Is sharp and in focus
- Is taken straight on, with a clear view of the face and shoulders, squared to the camera
- Is in color
- Is in JPEG format (HEIC cannot be accepted)
- Has been taken within the last 12 months to ensure up to date likeness
- Has your eyes open and clearly visible
- May have glasses worn, (as long as the eyes are clearly visible and the glasses do not present a glare resulting from the camera flash)
- Is submitted alongside the Testimonial Consent to Release Form

Notes about Head Coverings:

- Head coverings including hats and caps may render the submitted photograph inadmissible and result in the photo being rejected. It is recommended that head coverings are not worn.
- A photo with head covering for religious beliefs will be approved providing it shows full facial features and follows the above specifications.

Most importantly, don't forget to smile!

Photos will be rejected if:

- They have been photoshopped, or have the use of filters added
- Face is not clearly visible or partially covered
- Photo is very low resolution
- Photo is too dark
